DIP 420 VESSEL DECONTAMINATION

Moyno Pump Decontamination and Storage

1. Flush pump casing with fresh water.
2. Fill a barrel with water and detergent; put the ends of the suction and discharge hoses into the barrel. Connect the other ends of the hoses to the pump.
3. Connect the hydraulic power pack to the cargo pump motor and run the pump at slow to moderate speed until the unit is clean.
4. Flush the pump with fresh, clean water.
5. For long term storage of the cargo pump, fill the pump cavity with non-toxic polypropylene antifreeze/coolant.

DIP 420 Vessel Decontamination

The JBF 420 has been designed to minimize the time needed for decontamination. High-pressure water and detergents are the most effective methods.

1. Remove the skimmer, power pack and cargo pump from the vessel.
2. Open the cargo hatch.
3. Remove the port and starboard swash bulkheads by pulling them up through the hatch opening. The tank is now accessible for decon.
4. Flush the outboard engine with fresh water. If the operation was in heavy oil, adding a little detergent to the flushing water will help clean out the engines. **Do not run the engine without cooling water!**
